ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. ANNOUNCEMENT

Selby and District Motor Club will promote a Closed CoPromoted rally on the 28/29th January 1978.

2. REGULATIONS

The meeting will be governed by the General Competition Rules and the Standing Supplementary Regulations of the RAC, incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., these ASR's and any other written instructions the organisers may issue for the event.

3. AUTHORISATION PERMITS

RAC Permit No. has been issued for the event.
D. of E. Authorisation No. has been issued.

4. ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to all fully elected members of the Promoting Club and members of the following Clubs:- Alwoodley Motor Club, North Humberside Motor Club, Trackrod Motor Club, 62 Car Club, and Post Office Automobile Club.

Selby and District Motor Club membership fee is 20p per crew member payable with the entry fee. Full membership, including use of the Clubhouse, is available at £2.00 plus 50p Joining Fee.

Club membership cards will be inspected at signing on.

5. PROGRAMME

The event will start at Leedhams (York) Limited (M.R. 105/600518 $\frac{1}{2}$) and finish at Shiptonthorpe Service Station/Little Chef (M.R. 106/855427 $\frac{1}{2}$). Petrol will be available at both Half Way and Finish. The total mileage will not exceed 120 miles. Maps, nos 100/101/105/106 will be required.

6. SCRUTINEERING

Will begin at Leedhams (York) Limited at 20.30 hours. Any competitor not signed on, one hour before his due start time, will be excluded and his place taken by a reserve.
The level recorded at the noise test will not exceed 78 dba at 5000 rpm at a distance of 7 metres from one side of the car.

7. IDENTIFICATION

Cars will be identified by rally plates supplied by the organisers and by competition numbers as per B.B.1. (t). These and a limited supply of white squares will be on sale at the start.

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8. CLASSES

EXPERT - Where neither member of the crew has competed in a National or International Rally.

SEMI EXPERT - Where neither member of the crew has finished in the top ten of a Closed or top twenty of a Restricted Rally.

NOVICE - Where neither member of the crew has competed in an event of higher than Closed CoPromoted Status.

Out of category entries may be accepted subject to availability of places. These will not be eligible for major awards.

Awards will be presented at Selby and District Motor Club, Clubhouse at a date to be individually notified. Trophies marked with an asterisk* must be returned on or before the notified date.

10. ENTRIES

The maximum number of entries is 60 plus reserves. The minimum is 30. Should the minimum figure not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event. The entry list opens with the publication of these ASR's and closes on the 15th January 1978. Late entries may be accepted at the organisers' discretion up to the 24th January 1978.

10. ENTRIES (Continued).

The Entry Fee is £6.50. Late Entries £7.50. Teams of two cars at 50p per car with an award subject to a minimum of five teams. Team entries will be accepted on the night. All entries must be made on the official entry forms and accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. Post dated cheques will not be accepted. Refunds of entry fees will be at the organisers' discretion.

12. DOCUMENTATION

Full route instructions will be available so that competitors can comply with SSR. S 36. The route will be handed out at competitors' start time but there will be a long run out to MNTC 1 in which to plot up. Route definition will be by map references and by direction of approach and/or departure. Black spots and standing give ways will be given out at signing on.

13. RESULTS

Results will be published as soon as possible after the event. Protests must be made in accordance with SSR P.47 (a).

14. TIMING

The starting time of the first car will be 23.31 hours on Saturday, the 28th January 1978 with the rest of the field

following at one minute intervals.
Targa Timing will be used at each Time Control, ie. each competitor is due at successive controls at 00.00 hours plus his start number, eg. car no. 22 is due at all Time Controls at 00.22 hours.

15. MODIFICATION TO SSR's

All SSR's apply as written except:-

- P.40 Competitors may be in more than one team.
S.66 The 'Fail' system will apply
- (a) Not reporting at a control - ONE FAIL
 - (b) Arriving at a Control from the wrong direction - ONE FAIL
 - (c) Not complying with a requirement of the Route Card; Road Book or Final Instructions - ONE FAIL
 - (d) Using auxiliary lights in a quiet zone - First Offence - ONE FAIL
Second Offence - EXCLUSION
 - (e) Excessive noise at any time - First Offence - ONE FAIL
Second Offence - EXCLUSION.
 - (f) Departing early from a Control - TWO POINTS PER MINUTE.
 - (g) Arriving at a Control after due time - ONE POINT PER MINUTE.
 - (h) Failing to stop at a Standing Give Way - First Offence - THREE FAILS
Second Offence - EXCLUSION.
 - (i) Failing to report damage to property - EXCLUSION
 - (j) Entering an Out of Bounds Area - EXCLUSION.
 - (k) Selectives will be timed at 1/60th point per second.

16. GENERAL

All organisers' times and mileages are deemed to be correct. Should any controversy arise over any section of the route the organisers reserve the right, force majeure etc, notwithstanding, to cancel that section.
Ties will be decided by the furthest cleanest, and then by the smallest engine size.
Final Instructions will be posted in the week prior to the event.
Damage scrutineering will take place at the finish and an official damage declaration must be completed. Non finishers must ensure that this is sent to the Entries Secretary within seven days. Failure to do so will mean a report to the ANCC and to the RAC.
Unless instructed by the organisers, no competitor may use the same part of the route more than once - penalty - EXCLUSION.

INSURANCE

Competitors will be aware that many motor policies no longer cover competitive events, but arrangements have been made with the R.A.C.'s brokers Messrs C.T. Bowring and Muir Beddall (Home)Ltd. to give, subject to an acceptable proposal Third Party Cover (passenger liability included) at a premium of £6.00 payable before the start of the event.

Entrants wishing to avail themselves of this offer must apply with their entry for a Proposal Form and should note that this must be returned FULLY COMPLETED to the Secretary of the Meeting to arrive not less than FOURTEEN DAYS before the start of the event takes place.

All correspondence must be undertaken by the club and the brokers cannot deal direct with drivers either by correspondence or telephone.

Drivers who have already completed a proposal form should quote the reference number shown on the letter of acceptance, which MUST BE PRODUCED TO A CLUB OFFICIAL when paying the premium, before the event takes place.

Confirmation of cover, subject to the payment of the premium, which must be paid before the start, will be indicated with the final instructions to the individual competitors. In the (we hope) unlikely event of a proposal not being acceptable, the competitor should immediately contact his own insurers as the promoters cannot undertake to accept this as a reason for the return of the entry fee.

IT IS VITAL THAT COMPETITORS WISHING TO AVAIL THEMSELVES OF THIS INSURANCE COMPLY WITH THE TIMETABLE INDICATED.
