

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

ANNOUNCEMENT

The Selby and District Motor Club will organise a restricted permit Road Rally on 22/23 January 1983. Starting at The Little Chef, Pocklington.

2. REGULATIONS

The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the RAC Motor Sports Association Ltd., (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

AUTHORISATION

RAC MSA Permit No. RAL 2201/1 has been issued. DOE Authorisation has been applied for.

4. ELEGIBILITY

The event is open to:

- a) All fully elected members of the organising club.
- b) Members of Clubs of the ANCC, and Clubs contesting the Yorkshire Shellsport League, (subject to confirmation).
- 5. All competitors and drivers must produce a valid Competition Licence and Club Membership Card. Entrants Licences and Advertising permits must be available at scrutineering. Competitors attention is drawn to the conditions of Reg. F5.2.6.

6. CHAMPIONSHIPS

The event is a round of the ANCC Road Rally Championship, The Yorkshire Shellsport League, (to be confirmed) and the Humberside M.S.G. Rally Championship.

PROGRAMME

The programme of the meeting will be: Scrutineering starts at 19.00 hrs. Individual times for scrutineering will be notified in Final Instructions. Any competitor not signed on by two hours before their start time may be excluded.
First car starts at 23.31 hrs.

8. ROUTE

Cars will start at one minute intervals.

Map nos. 100, 101 and 106 (1:50000 series latest editions) will be required.

The finish will be at The Little Chef, Shiptonthorpe. The event will contain competitive sections on the public road timed to an accuracy of less than one minute. The total mileage will approx. 150 miles.

9. CLASSES

- a) The event will consist of three classes as follows:-
- i) EXPERT Where either member of the crew has finished in top ten of a restricted rally or the top five of a closed/copromoted rally (excluding novice rallies)
- ii)SEMI- Where either member of the crew has finished in EXPERT the top 25 of a restricted rally or the top 15 of a closed/copromoted rally (and does not qualify as an EXPERT).
- iii)NOV- Where neither member of the crew qualifies for the ICE EXPERT or SEMI-EXPERT class
- b) All vehicles must comply with the RAC MSA technical regulations especially QA and QH.

11. ENTRY

The entry list opens on publication of these supplementary regulations and closes finally on 8th January 1983. The entry fee is £19.00

All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

12. ENTRY SECRETARY

13. ENTRIES

The maximum number of entries per class is 40.

The minimum number for each class is 10.

The maximum entry for the meeting including reserves is 105. The minimum is 50.

Should any of the minimum figures above not be reached, the organisers have the right to amalgamate classes or cancel the meeting.

Entries will be selected in order of date received, providing they are complete in all respects.

Entry fees may be refunded as follows:

- a) In full, if withdrawn in writing before 8th January.
- b) In full, subject to a small administrative charge, if withdrawn in writing after the 9th January and before the 19th January if a reserve entry fills the vacancy. Otherwise any refund will be at the discretion of the organisers. No refund will be despatched until after the event. Entries will be acknowledged by telephone wherever possible.

15. RESULTS

Provisional results will be published within two hours of the finish.

16. PROTESTS

Any protest must be lodged in accordance with L.1.14.7.

17. DOCUMENTATION

Entrants will be supplied with a route card at one hour before their due start time. This document will provide all the information necessary to enable competitors to comply with Regulations L.4.3.3. and L.4.9.7. Competitors will be required to make up lateness at the rest halt.

18. Out of bounds areas and quiet zones will be supplied to each competitor as per L.4.3.5.

- 19. Competitors will be identified by rally plates, supplied by the organisers and side numbers supplied by the competitors. Side numbers will be on sale prior to, and must be attached before the car is presented for scrutineering.
- 20. MODIFICATION TO SSR'S

Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the RAC MSA general regulations L.4.13.5. except as modified below:

The Fails System will apply except:-

- Departing from a competitive time control before due time - 2 marks/min
- m. Arriving after corrected time at a competitive time control:-

When timed to the minute - 1 mark/minute When timed to the second - 1/60 mark/second

- s. Damaged or ineffective silencing system exclusion
- t. Damage to vehicle 1 fail
- u. Receiving assistance contrary to L.4.7. exclusion Depositing litter around the start venue exclusion Competitors attention is also drawn to L.4.9.1. (Judges of Fact)
- 21. GENERAL INFORMATION
- a) Petrol will be available after approx. 80 miles
- b) Full breakfasts will be available at the finish at $\pounds 2.00$ per person
- c) Timing will be by marshalls clocks using the Targa systems
- d) Force majeure not withstanding, the organisers reserve the right to delete penalties at any control or check and/or delete any part of the route should they deem it fair to do so
- e) The organisers times and mileages are deemed to be correct
- f) Competitors must hand in at the final time control (or, in the case of retirement, send to the Secretary of the meeting within 48 hours of the finish) a damage report form giving details of any incident resulting in damage to property or persons during the event. Information thus given will not incur a penalty. Failure to comply, or to give a false declaration will result in exclusion and a report made to the RAC MSA, ANCC, HMSG (if appropriate) and the competitors own club. The report must be completed even if no damage occurs. Scrutineering at the start will note existing damage, and cars will be re-scrutineered for damage at the final time control. Completion of the damage form does not release the competitor from his obligations as required by the law to report to the

Police any accident or damage to property on or near the public highway, whether it caused damage or injury to those present or not. Road side verges are part of the public highway

- g) Maximum lateness will be 31 minutes at all controls except the finish control where it will be 45 minutes h) Air intake filters <u>MUST</u> be of the foam or paper type, wire gauze will not be allowed. Vehicles not complying will fail scrutineering
- i) Competitors are reminded of the exclusion penalty for depositing litter around the Pocklington start area

22. INSURANCE

Arrangements have been made with the RAC MSA brokers,

C. T. Bowring (Motorsport), to give third party cover subject
to an acceptable proposal at a cost to be determined (see
entry form). Entrants wishing to avail themselves of this
offer must apply with their entry for a proposal form and
should note that this should be returned fully completed
to the Secretary of the meeting to arrive not less than
fourteen days before the start of the event.

All correspondence must be undertaken by the club and the brokers cannot deal direct with individual drivers either by correspondence or telephone.

Drivers who have already completed the proposal form for events since 1st December 1972 should quote the reference number shown on their letter of acceptance, which must be produced to a club official when paying the premium before the event takes place.

Confirmation of cover subject to the payment of the premium which must be paid before the start will be indicated with the final instructions to individual competitors. In the (we hope) unlikely event of any proposal not being acceptable the competitor should immediately contact his own insurers, as promoters cannot undertake to accept this as any reason for return of entry fee.
