



ANNOUNCEMENT.

The Selby & District Motor Club will organise a restricted permit Road Rally on the 24th/25th January, 1987 starting at the Hazlebush Cafe, Malton Road, York.

REGULATIONS.

The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the RAC Motorsports Association Ltd., (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA.), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

AUTHORISATION.

RACMSA Permit No. TBA has been issued. DOE Authorisation has been applied for.

4. ELIGIBILITY.

The event is open to:

- a) All fully elected members of the organising club.
- b) All fully elected members of clubs affiliated to the ANCC or the ANECCC.

LICENCES.

All Competitor's must produce a valid competition licence and club membership cards.

Competitors attention is drawn to 6.R. F. 5.2.6.

CHAMPIONSHIPS.

21 GENERAL INFORMATION.

Petrol will be available after 80 and 150 miles.

Timing will be by marshal's clocks using the Targa system.

Force majeure not withstanding, the organisers reserve the right to delete penalties at any control or check or delete any part of the route should it be deemed fair to do so.

To be classified as a finisher, competitors must visit two thirds of all controls and visit all main time controls within their maximum permitted lateness.

Competitors must hand in at the final control (or in the case of retirement, send to the secretary of the meeting within 48 hours of the finish) their damage declaration form, with details of any incident which resulted in damage to any third party during the event. Failure to comply or to give a false declaration will result in exclusion and a report made to the RACMSA, ANCC, ANECCC, HMSG, TMSG and the competitors' own club. The damage declaration must be completed even if no damage occurs. At no time does the completion of the damage declaration form release the competitor from his legal obligations to report to the Police any accident or damage to property on or near the public highway, whether it caused damage or injury to those present or not. Roadside verges are a part of the public highway. Maximum lateness will be thirty minutes at all controls.

22. NAVIGATION.

The correct route will be by the shortest route on any road marked on the map, between controls avoiding no-goers and out of bounds areas, complying with the road book.

If any road marked on the map as a footpath, or not at all is to be used, details will be given in the road book.

Competitors are reminded that the penalty for littering any of the venues used for the event and divulging route information to spectators is exclusion.

INSURANCE.

Arrangements have been made with the RACMSA brokers C. T. Bowring (Motorsport) to give third party insurance cover subject to an accepted proposal and at a cost to be determined. Entrants wishing to avail themselves of this offer must apply with their entry form and should note that this should be returned fully completed in all respects to the Secretary of the meeting to arrive not later than 14 days before the start of the event. All correspondence must be undertaken by the club and the brokers cannot deal with individual correspondence or telephone conversations. Drivers who have already completed the proposal form since 1st December 1972 should quote the reference number shown on their letter of acceptance, which must be produced to a club official when paying the premium before the event takes place.


