

Cottingham MOT Centre Station Mills, Station Yard



Thank you for your entry on our event, your start number is as per. the attached entry list.

#### PROGRAMME

Please fill up with petrol before arriving at noise. If you are arriving from the South, Tyke Petroleum in Selby 105/610322 is open until 8pm. If you are arriving from the East there is a 24hour Petrol station Coastways, York Road, Shiptonthorpe at 105/639514 and If you are arriving from the North the Tescos on the northern ring road at Clifton Moor, York is a 24 hour station.

Noise check is located at Selby and District Motor Club at 105 or 106/717345. It will be sign posted, ase do not speed down the lane to the clubhouse, it is a bit rough and we don't want our neighbours to complain or anything to drop off your car. Please approach via ref. 710.5 345 just go straight down the track and follow the marshals' instructions/arrows. Noise will open at 21:00 on 14<sup>th</sup> December

After Noise Check proceed on the marshals' instructions to scrutineering. Your scrutineering time is 21:10 hrs plus your start number in minutes.

On successfully passing Scrutineering park as directed by marshals proceed to signing on and hand in your completed scrutineering sheet. Signing on is located in Selby and District Motor Clubs licensed clubhouse.

#### 3. Authorisation

MSA Permit Number: 14063

Pack Authorisation number will be displayed on the Official notice board at the start.

#### 7. Route

Map 106 edition C or C1 may be used. (The navigation has been checked for both editions) The mileage on "white" roads is less than 2 miles.

#### 10. Technical Regulations

Car derived Vans / Pickups are permitted on this event.

#### 12. Officials

The Stewards are Graham Harper, John Chadwick and John Roberts.

#### 14. Documentation

Route instructions may contain the following abbreviations:

Y - yellow road, B - brown road, LWR - long way round, SWR - short way round

 $\Delta$  - triangle. This refers to grass triangles, usually at junctions. Thus LWR $\Delta$  means long way round grass triangle.

TC - time control. TTC - transport time control. STC - standard time control. PC - passage check

Note on Transport Sections: We have used these in built up areas in place of Neutrals. (Neutrals must be timed at 20 mph.) We have aimed to keep to a compact time schedule. Please treat all Transport Sections as Quiet zones.

Note on Level Crossings: The route crosses 5 railway level crossings. 4 of these are located in Transport sections and hence penalties are not incurred in case of a delay at the crossing. The 5<sup>th</sup> is located at an STC where you will receive an arrival time and a departure time (next whole minute). In the event of a delay at the level crossing, the time difference between arrival and departure will be "dead time" which is not penalised.

Note on Grid References: These use the following syntax:

approach direction (if used), reference (6 figures or more where fractions are used), depart direction (if used)

e.g. NNE 123 1/2 456 3/4 SSW.

#### 16. Penalties

For clarification: The **Fails System K18** will be followed, with the exception of incorrectly recorded Foresage Control Boards, for which the penalty will be 5 minutes.


